## **ORDINANCE** #2003-3

## AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A 45 MILE PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT UPON A PORTION OF COUNTY ROAD 23.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to SDCL 32-24-9.1, the Board of County Commissioners may determine and establish speed zones upon all or any part of the highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, because of the high volume of traffic; the large number of entrances and exits to and from residences; and the nature and condition of the road involved, it appears necessary to reduce the speed limit on a portion of Brookings County Road 23 to provide for the safety and welfare of all residents and travelers on such road.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that a speed limit of 45 miles per hour be and the same is hereby established on that portion of Brookings County Road 23 commencing at the intersection of Brookings County Road 23 and U.S. Highway 14 and continuing south to the north municipal limits of the City of Aurora, Brookings County, South Dakota.
