

ORDINANCE #2008-8

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A 45 MILE PER HOUR
SPEED LIMIT UPON A PORTION OF COUNTY ROADS: 473rd AVENUE (34TH AVE.) and 210th
STREET (30TH ST.).**

WHEREAS, Pursuant to SDCL 32-24-9.1, the Board of County Commissioners may determine and establish speed zones upon all or any part of the highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, The Brookings County Commission has received a request from the City of Brookings to post speed limit below the default 55 mph due to the number of complaints received about vehicles traveling at high speeds on the listed roads;

WHEREAS, Because of the high volume of traffic and the nature and condition of the road involved, it appears necessary to reduce the speed limit on a portion of Brookings County Roads to provide for the safety and welfare of all residents and travelers on such road.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that a speed limit of 45 miles per hour be and the same is hereby established on that portion of Brookings County Roads as described below:

- A road beginning at the Southwest (SW) Corner of Section Seventeen (17) in Township One Hundred Ten (110) North, Range Forty-nine (49) West of the 5th P.M., Brookings County, South Dakota, and progressing in a Northerly direction for a distance of approximately 1.0 miles.
- A road beginning in the Northwest (NW) Corner of Section Seventeen (17) in Township One Hundred Ten (110) North, Range Forty-nine (49) West of the 5th P.M., Brookings County, South Dakota, and progressing in an Easterly direction for a distance of approximately 1.0 miles.

The City maintains 34th Avenue from Highway 14 Bypass to 30th Street, and 30th Street from 34th Avenue to one mile east. We have noticed there are no speed limit signs posted on these streets, which we understand would default the speed limit to 55 miles per hour.

I respectfully request the Brookings County Commission to consider reducing the speed limit to 45 miles per hour for 34th Avenue from Highway 14 Bypass to 30th Street, and 30th Street from 34th Avenue to one mile east. RESOLUTION NO. 91-35

A RESOLUTION ADDING CERTAIN ROADS TO
THE BROOKINGS COUNTY HIGHWAY SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings will be constructing a new landfill to serve the Brookings area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings new landfill will also receive solid waste from communities and individuals throughout Brookings County; and

WHEREAS, BROOKINGS COUNTY has previously obligated itself to assist in improving the existing roads to such landfill site, which improvements appear to be of county-wide concern; and

WHEREAS, such roads to be improved are presently township roads located in Aurora Township, Brookings County, South Dakota, and it will be desirable and necessary to add such roads to the County Highway System.

BE IT RESOLVED that the following roads, situate in Aurora Township, be added to the Brookings County Highway System, effective January 1, 1992:

A road beginning at the Southwest (SW) Corner of Section Seventeen (17) in Township One Hundred Ten (110) North, Range Forty-nine (49) West of the 5th P.M., Brookings County, South Dakota, and progressing in a Northerly direction for a distance of approximately 1.0 miles.

A road beginning in the Northwest (NW) Corner of Section Seventeen (17) in Township One Hundred Ten (110) North, Range Forty-nine (49) West of the 5th P.M., Brookings County, South Dakota, and progressing in an Easterly direction for a distance of approximately 1.0 miles.




SEC. 8 - T110N - R49W


