

# **BROOKINGS COUNTY COMMISSION STUDY SESSION**

## **TUESDAY, AUGUST 10, 2021**

The Brookings County Board of County Commissioners held a study session on Tuesday, August 10, 2021 with the following members present: Larry Jensen, Angela Boersma, Lee Ann Pierce, Ryan Krogman and Michael Bartley.

Also present were: States Attorney Dan Nelson, Deputy States Attorney Ben Kleinjan, County Development Director Robert Hill, County Development Deputy Director Richard Haugen, Commission Department Director Stacy Steffensen and Jail Sergeant Dave Biteler.

The board reviewed the drafts of the following ordinances pertaining to the legalization of medical marijuana:

Ordinance #2021-06: An ordinance creating licensing provisions for medical cannabis dispensaries; Ordinance #2021-07: An ordinance prohibiting the smoking of cannabis in public places; and Ordinance #2021-08: An ordinance entitled, an ordinance to amend article IV chapter 4.02 “commercial / industrial districts” section 4.02.02 adopted by ordinance #2018-03. An ordinance to add article III, section 3.03.02 “prohibited uses”. An ordinance to add article V, “general requirements.” An ordinance to add an article II, “definitions.”

The First Reading of Ordinance #21-06 and Ordinance #21-07 is scheduled for Tuesday, August 17, 20201 at 8:30 a.m.
