

# **2020 BROOKINGS COUNTY INVITATIONAL WINTER CALF SHOW RULES**

## **• COVID-19 ERA EVENT RULES**

- **ALL in attendance MUST wear a mask while in the Holding Barn**
- Participants and spectators must maintain proper social/physical distance from others while in the Holding Barn.
- No more than 60 people within the building.
- Invitational Show Counties included: Brookings, Codington, Deuel, Hamlin, Kingsbury, Lake, Miner, and Moody.
- **Entry fee- \$30 per calf entered.**
- Entry fees payable to Brookings County Winter Calf Show.
- Entry fees due at check-in.
- Registrations will be accepted the day of show until 10 am.
- **No Fit Show; washing facilities will not be available.**
- Market animals will not be weighed, declare weight at the time of registration.
- Health papers and proper registration papers are required, excluding commercial. Failure of paperwork will result in the commercial division placement.
- Feeder calves must be born in 2020. Fall heifers are eligible too but must be born in the 2019 year.
- 4-H ages limited to 8-18 years old as of January 1 of the current year.
- Exhibitor numbers will be available at registration.
- Classes to be determined after calves are registered.
- Contest will be broken down by age and division (British and Continental) for breeding heifers.
- Contest will be broken down by weight and division (British and Continental) for steers and weight only for market heifers.
- All decisions of the Judge and Show Committee are final.
- Not responsible for accidents.
- No pets allowed in the Swiftel Center Holding Barn.
- 4-H Code of Conduct applies to this event for all youth and adults.

- Storm Date will be determined if necessary.
